



Student Activity Fund

What is the Student Activity Fund?

The fund is used to assist students during the school year who **cannot** participate in class-wide curriculum related or academic activities without financial assistance. After school athletic activities are not awarded under this fund. Students requiring financial assistance may appeal. If a student is participating or performing in a national competition additional funds may be available.

Who is eligible?

Students UPK-12 enrolled in the Hilton Center School District are eligible to apply.

How to apply?

Students at the elementary and middle school levels must have a teacher or parent fill out the application. **Applications may not be mass produced, i.e. statement of need etc. copied for a group of students participating in the same activity. Each application must be individualized.** The application must be signed by the parent (legal guardian), the sponsoring teacher and the school principal. High school students may apply for themselves and must include the same signatures listed above.

Deadline for requests:

Applications must be received by the **first day of each month** to be reviewed at the mid-month committee meeting. **Applications must be received before the scheduled activity.**

Selection:

A committee appointed by the Hilton Education Foundation will review all applications. Applicants will be notified after the mid-month committee meeting. All decisions are subject to the discretion of the committee.
