

Brian Scroger Memorial Scholarship

To recognize a graduating, college-bound Hilton High School Senior with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher who has lost a parent or guardian or who has experienced severe medical challenges themselves.

Brian was a 1982 graduate of Hilton High School. While attending college, he was diagnosed with cardiomyopathy and received a heart transplant. Through faith, courage, determination and a refusal-to-give-up-despite-the-odds mentality, he completed his education at the University of Buffalo, underwent a second heart transplant in 1995, and continued to enrich the lives of those who knew him. Brian died in 2011 at the age of 47. His family founded this award to thank the Hilton community who generously supported Brian during his medical battles and to continue Brian's support of higher education.
