- The applicant will submit three letters of recommendation. 2 should be from school educators or faculty, and one from a school or community leadership or volunteer coordinator.
- Official High School Transcript
- The application should be submitted to the Hilton High School Counseling office, attention: Hilton Education Foundation.
- Submission deadline is May 1st.
- The Hilton Education Foundation Board will make the decision and announce at Bravo night.
