

Dr. James D. Nundy Scholarship Application

Dr. James Nundy was a 1933 Hilton High School graduate who received his Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine from Michigan State University in 1937. His veterinary practice served the Hilton community until 1986 when he died at the age of 68.

His widow, Dorothy Nundy, generously donated \$10,000.00 to initiate a permanently restricted endowed scholarship which is awarded in the amount of \$2,000.00, known as the **James D. Nundy Scholarship**.

This scholarship is administered by the Estate of Dean M. Snyder, DVM, through the Hilton Education Foundation.
