ALAN MULLAN---HILTON HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE
CLASS OF 1985

Al Mullan grew up in Hilton, NY, and was a standout athlete on the cross country and track teams at Hilton High School. He attended Jacksonville University where he was a member of the JU cross country and track teams. Al was active for several years in the Jacksonville Track Club, marathons, including the Boston Marathon and one in Prague. He was elected into the Hilton Athletic Hall Of Fame in 2001. Al passed away on April 29, 2014
